

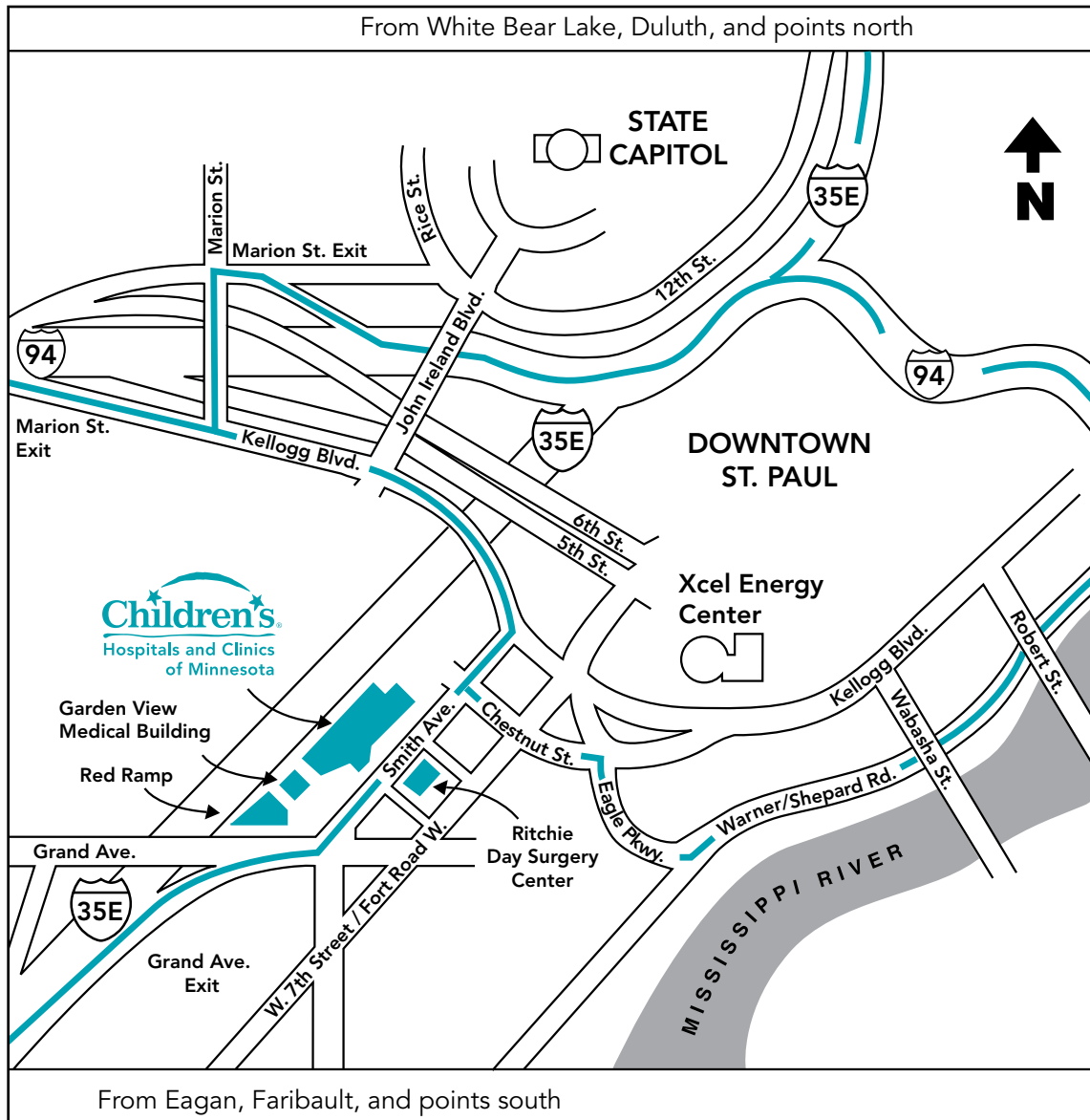
How to get to Children's - St. Paul

A From the North

Travel I-35E south to I-94 west. Exit at Marion Street. Turn left and follow Kellogg Boulevard to Smith Avenue. Turn right on Smith Avenue. Children's - St. Paul is three blocks ahead on the right. See P below for parking information.

B From the West

Travel east on I-94, exit at Marion Street. Turn right and follow Kellogg Boulevard to Smith Avenue. Turn right on Smith Avenue. Children's - St. Paul is three blocks ahead on the right. See P below for parking information.

C From the South via I-35E

Travel I-35E north and exit at Grand Avenue. Turn right onto Grand Avenue. Travel one block to Smith Avenue, and turn left. Children's - St. Paul is on the left. See P below for parking information.

D From the South via Hwy 61

Travel north on Hwy 61 to Warner/Shepard Road. Follow Shepard Road to Eagle Parkway/Chestnut Street, and turn right. Turn left on Chestnut Street. Follow to Smith Avenue, and turn left. Children's - St. Paul is two blocks ahead on the right. See P below for parking information.

E From the East

Travel west on I-94, exit at Marion Street. Turn left and follow Kellogg Boulevard to Smith Avenue. Turn right on Smith Avenue. Children's - St. Paul is three blocks ahead on the right. See P below for parking information.

P Parking

The Red Ramp is the closest to the Children's - St. Paul main entrance and can be accessed through the Garden View Medical Building. The Green Ramp is the closest to the Ritchie Day Surgery Center. All ramps have access to the hospital by tunnel. Ramp clearance is 6'8" in the Green Ramp and 7' in all others. Only on level 4, 5, and 6 in the Blue Ramp will visitors need to use stairs to access elevators. Parking fees are posted at each ramp entrance.
