- A physician's order is not required for these tests.
- Come directly to Children's laboratory --do not register at the admitting desk.
- You must pay for the tests in advance by cash, check, or credit card; Children's will not bill your insurance.
- The tests are available Monday -Friday, 7 a.m. to 7.p.m. No appointment is needed. Limited service is available on weekends; please call ahead to check.
- Depending on the testing, you may wait for the results or choose to have them mailed directly to you. You are encouraged to share them with your health care provider.
- Any one under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
