Peer Review of Forensic Interviews

Purpose of Clinical Initiative - Peer Review of Forensic Interviews

The purpose of peer review of forensic interviews will be to provide the opportunity for participants to review forensic interviews, discuss specific interview techniques, and provide feedback regarding the quality of documentation.

Goals of Clinical Initiative

1. To provide forensic interviewers the opportunity to network with other interviewers in the Midwest Region.
2. To increase the knowledge of forensic interviewers in the Midwest Region.
3. To provide the opportunity to discuss forensic interviews and provide feedback regarding those interviews in cases of suspected child abuse or neglect.
4. To enhance the quality of documentation of forensic interviews in cases of suspected child abuse in the Midwest Region.
