## Graduate Medical Education Matters

- Children's Hospitals and Clinics of Minnesota (Children's) is committed to training the next generation of pediatric subspecialty physicians.
- Last year, Children's received \$3.2 million in federal CHGME funding. These dollars enabled Children's to provide training for over 350 residents and fellows in 15??? different pediatric specialties.

## Medicaid Matters

- In 2006, Medicaid covered 49,276 of Children's in-patient days. 37.4% percent of Children's revenue comes from Medicaid, making Medicaid Children's largest single source of revenue.
- Medicaid disproportionate share (DSH) payments are critical to Children's future. In 2007, Children's DSH share was \$18.5 million.
- Medicaid is the largest children's health program in the country. Twenty-eight percent of Minnesota's children (363,000 children) are enrolled in Medicaid. Reduction in Medicaid reverberates throughout our state and throughout Children's.
- In order for Children's to continue providing innovative, high quality health care to the children in our community, Medicaid must be protected.
