Case Tracking Event Icons

Event icons display in columns in Case Tracking to allow surgeons, nurses, and the patient's family to easily identify the current status of a patient's procedure.

The PreOp Nursing Assessment is Complete.		The IntraOp column will display the following five icons as the patient's case progresses.

CRNA Interview.		Begin closing.

Case Tracking Color Changes

Late Start Notification PeriOp/White Board

The board flashes color to indicate late start information:

- 30 minutes after the scheduled start time has passed, the start time cell flashes in peach.
Family Updated (1) is set by the PreOp staff which will stop the flashing, but the cell remains in peach.
- 30 minutes after *Family Updated (1)* is set, the time cell flashes in medium orange.
Family Updated Again (2) is set by the PreOp staff which will stop the flashing but the cell remains in medium orange.
- 30 minutes after *Family Updated Again (2)* is set, the time cell flashes in dark orange.
Family Updated Final (3) is set by the PreOp staff which will stop the flashing, but the cell remains in dark orange until the patient in OR is documented in the IntraOp record.
