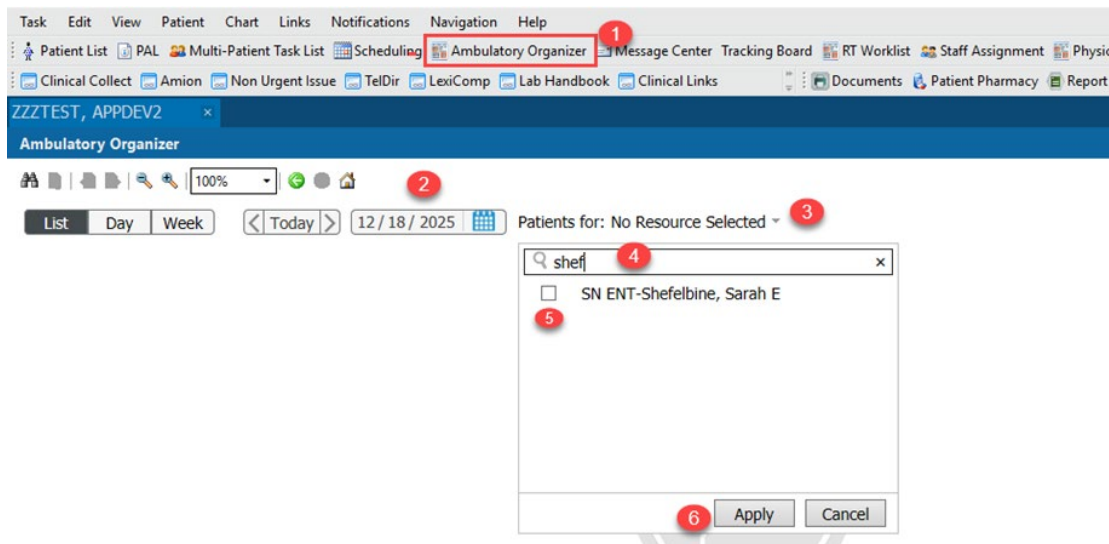


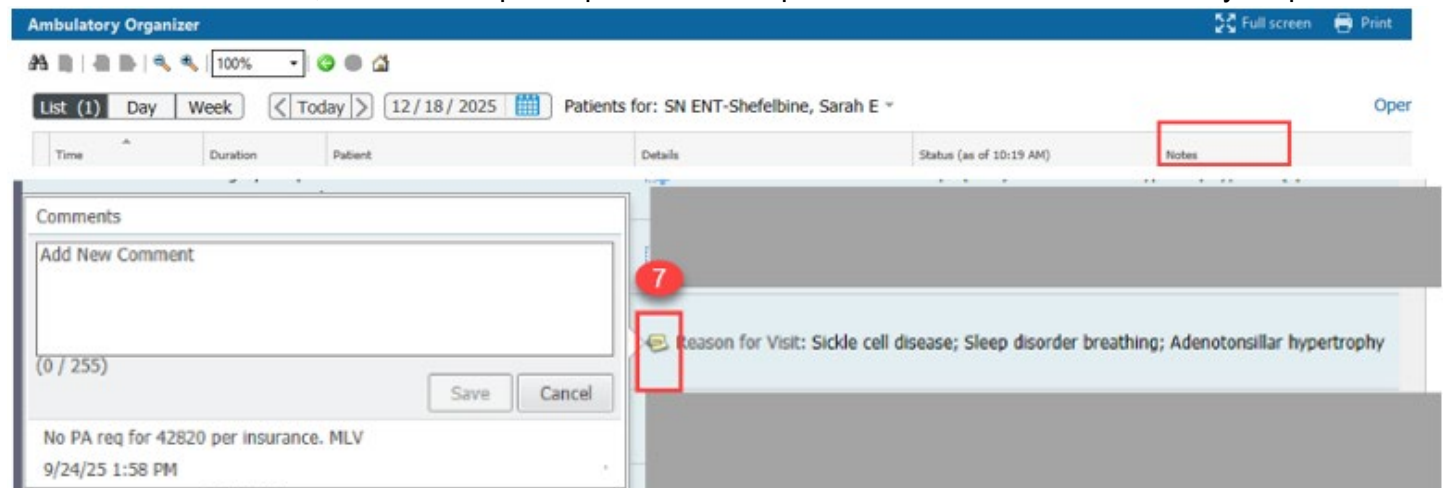
Reviewing Prior Authorization Surgery Status

Prior authorization (PA) will be in place for patients having a Tonsillectomy with or without an Adenoidectomy (T&A). Knowing the patient's prior authorization status will help determine and support the best path for additional observation after surgery. Review patients scheduled for a surgical procedure in Cerner using the Ambulatory Organizer.

1. Select the Ambulatory Organizer icon.
2. Select the surgery date.
3. After Patient's for, Select No Resource Selected or name.
4. Type in surgeon's last name.
5. Place a check mark.
6. Select apply.



7. From Notes column, select the Paper Clip to review the prior authorization information on your patient.



If the patient requires additional observation, consider the prior authorization of information. Orders to Admit to Inpatient or Place in Observation must be entered by the surgeon.
