HTML5 Remote Desktop

The HTML5 option is not platform-dependent; it can be used on any browser and with any operating system. It is not Java-dependent.

If you have access to a Remote Desktop, the **HTML5** Access Sessions title bar will display after you log into Children's Secure Access.

After you set up a HTML5 Access session, it can be used to remote into a Children's computer desktop. If you require Remote Desktop access to a Children's computer and do not have access, please call the Children's ITS Service Desk 24/7 at 952-992-5000 or 4-5000 internally.

To set up an HTML5 access session:

1. Log in to Children's Secure Access (https://www.childrensmn.org/signin) using your Children's network username and password.

2. Click the sicon in the **HTML5** Access Sessions title bar to open the Add HTML5 Access Session window.
