CAFETERIA/FOOD

Minneapolis

• Cafeteria – Located on the 1st floor. Hours of operation: Monday-Friday hot food available 6:30a.m. - 9:30a.m. and 11:00 a.m. - 1:45 p.m.; Micro market open daily

St. Paul

- MicroMart Located on the 1st floor. Hours of operation: vending 24/7
- Ginko Located on the 1st floor Children's Hospital near gift shop entrance. Hours of Operation: Monday Friday 6:30a.m. 4:30p.m.
- United Hospital Cafeteria Located on the 1st floor of United Hospital near main entrance (adjacent to the Deli Bean and United Gift Shop). Hours of operation: Café closed daily from 10-11 a.m. Monday Friday 6:30 a.m. 7:30 p.m.; Saturday-Sunday 7 a.m. 7:30 p.m.

DRESS CODE

Students are expected to maintain a clean, well-groomed appearance in the clinical setting. The following are the expectations:

IDENTIFICATION BADGES

PARKING (Our Locations)

Minneapolis: Parking stickers can be purchased for \$4/day at the cashier's office on the 2nd floor of the hospital. Please have your student ID with you to prove that you are a student.
