

Acknowledge Function for Discharge Medication Reconciliation

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A new **Acknowledge Remaining Home Meds** button will be available to assist in the reconciliation of home medications. This feature allows the specialist to address unreconciled home medications that are managed by others.

- Clinicians can quickly address all home medications and complete medication reconciliation without the need to verify dosing, ongoing relevance, or medication management regarding medications for which they are not accountable.
- Clinicians can address remaining home medications they did not prescribe/manage by clicking the **Acknowledge Remaining Home Meds** button.
- This will result in patients having an accurate, active medication list to check for duplicate meds, known allergies, pharmacogenomics, and medication interactions without the clinician taking accountability for dosing and review of medications managed by others.

Reconciling Medications

Home Medications

All home medications requiring reconciliation are indicated by an orange star. These can be addressed in two ways:

- Reconcile: Manually reconcile meds you prescribe/manage.
- Acknowledge: Click the Acknowledge Remaining Home Meds button for the home medications you do not manage.

Medications

- Ongoing protocol orders that have been ordered for an upcoming visit should default to automatically continue. **Do not discontinue or remove** orders that are automatically set to continue.
- If they do not default to continue, they need to be addressed. If you manage the order, reconcile appropriately. If you do not manage the order, you must click Continue. **Do not discontinue or remove.**
