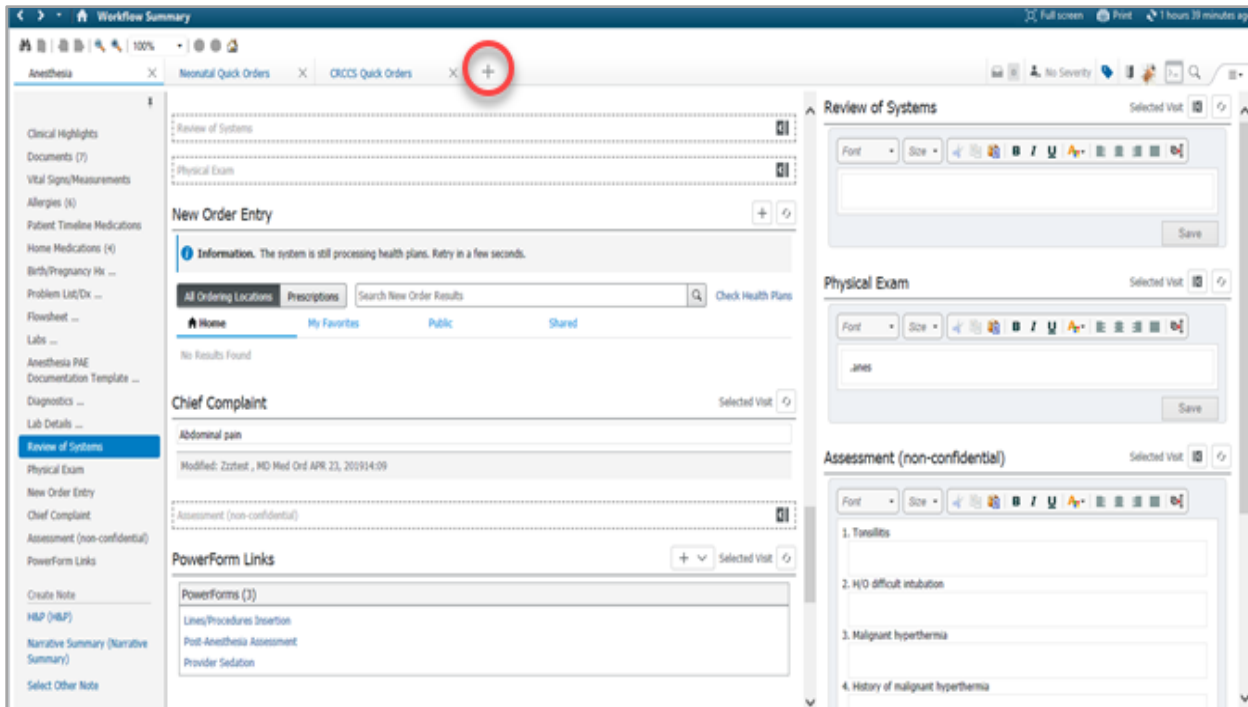


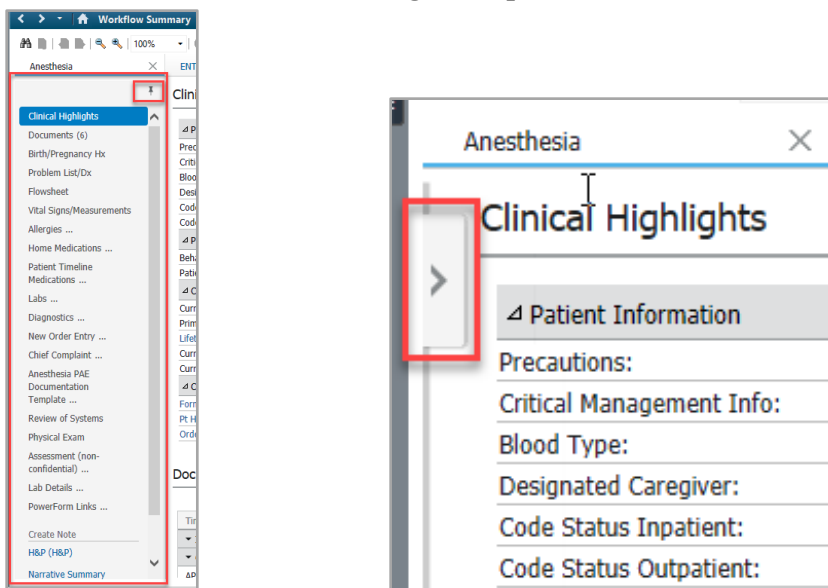
Anesthesia Workflow Summary and Quick Orders Page

The Anesthesia Workflow Summary page is the default page upon opening a chart. This page layout allows chart review and documentation to take place on a single page.

Click the  to add the Anesthesia and Quick Orders Workflow Summary pages to your view.



The Anesthesia Workflow Component List is on the left side of the page. The Component List can be pinned to remain visible. Unpin it to close the view. It will open when hovering over the Settings icon. This is a fully customizable list. Click and drag a component to move it to create a customized list order.

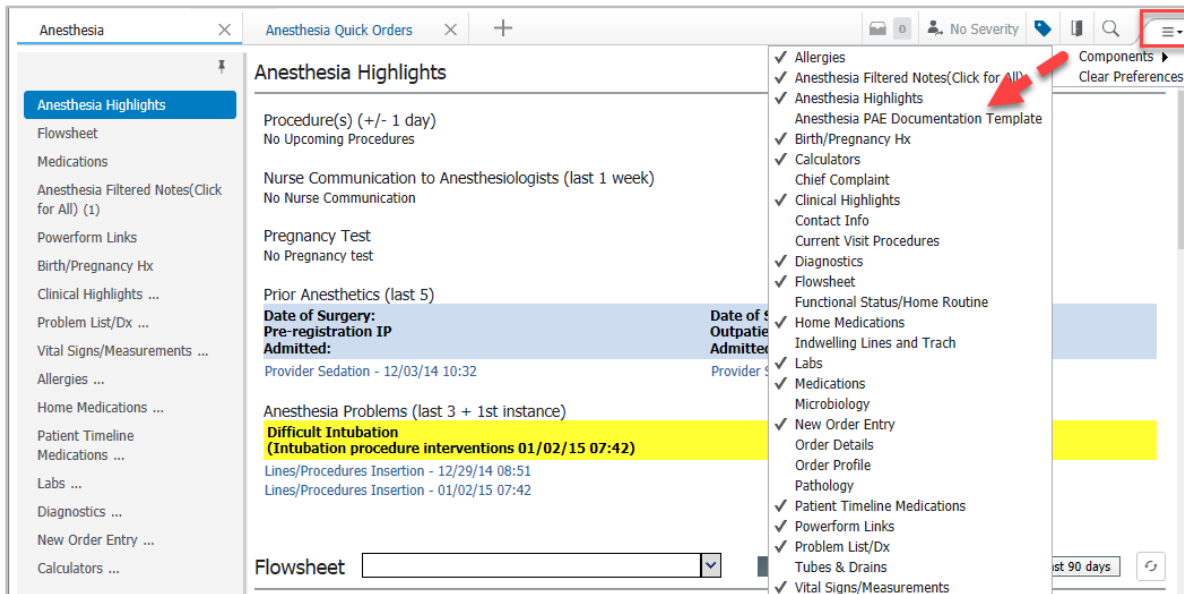

Hidden Component List

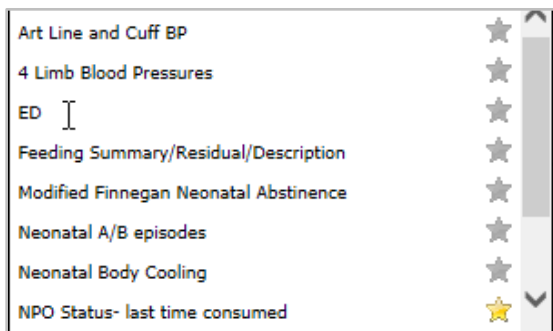
The component list can be customized by adding or removing components. Click the Settings button to view a full list of components. Checked items display and unchecked items are hidden from the preferred view.




Anesthesia Filtered Notes (Click for All)

- Customize filters to display Prior Anesthetics by clicking **Change Filter** and selecting **Prior Anesthetics**.




- Select a note to open. A preview pane will display the note and selecting **View Document** will open the note to the finalized view. An open note can be modified, placed in error, or forwarded.
