- 1. From an open patient chart, click the Report icon.
- 2. Click the pencil icon in the **Patient Education** section.

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- 3. The Instructions tab displays.
- 4. Ensure **All** is selected.
- 5. Search for the appropriate **Patient Education.**
 - Note: A specialty i.e., Cardiology, can be selected.
- 6. Select the preferred patient language. English Hmong, Somali or Spanish are available currently.
 - The instructions display in the preferred language in the **Selected Instructions** section. **Note**: The preferred language displays in parentheses following the instruction.
- 7. Click to highlight the instructions in the **Selected Instructions** section.
- 8. Click **Sign** to sign the Patient Education section.



9. Click **Print/Sign** to print the Clinic Visit Summary.

Note: This process only changes the preferred language for the special instructions. It does not change the language preference on the entire Clinical Summary.
