

PowerChart Touch Voice Recognition



Voice recognition is built into PowerChart Touch and can be used with an iPhone or iPad. This is not the same profile as used with Fluency Direct but works in a similar way.

Using Dictation

1. Tap into a free text dictation area noted by a flame icon  to begin using voice recognition.



2. Tap the microphone icon  to toggle from **Standby** (blue) to **On** (green) and begin dictation.



- When the microphone is on, voice commands can be used to toggle between **On** and **Standby**.
 - Say **Go to Sleep** to put microphone into **Standby** mode.
 - Say **Wake Up** to turn microphone on.
- Sound bars next to the microphone icon  will display in green while you are speaking.



Note: A red microphone indicates microphone is off. Tap the microphone icon  to turn it on again. Say **Microphone off** to turn off microphone.

Auto-text (Commands)

Cerner .dot phrases can be executed by typing only. Dot phrases cannot be voice enabled at this time.

Custom Auto-texts

- Can only be added by an administrator.
- Custom Auto-texts can be added for an individual user or a group of users.
Note: These are different from .dot phrases as they are only available in PowerChart Touch and may only contain plain text.

Request a custom Auto-text

1. Email request to mmodalsupportteam@childrensmn.org
2. Include Auto-text Name (i.e., **Insert normal review of systems**) and content of Auto-text.

Available Auto-texts

Next Field: Selects the [bracket field] within the Auto-text or navigates to the next free text box.

Next Tag: Selects the _ (underscore) within the Auto-text.

Save Documentation: Saves the text within the free text box.

Accept Defaults: Removes the [brackets] around the text; the text remains.

Select <word>: Selects word to edit or replace.

Delete that: Deletes selected text.

Undo that or **Scratch that:** Removes last utterance.

What can I say?: Opens **What You Can Say** menu i.e., Auto-texts, Correction, Navigation, etc.

Back to Dictation: Exits **What You Can Say** menu and brings you back to your note.


What Can I Say Menu

Access the **What You Can Say** menu to view available Auto-texts.


1. Tap menu bars (horizontal lines below) and tap **What You Can Say**.

Or


2. Say **What can I say?**




3. Tap the Auto-texts option.




A list of your commands displays.



4. Tap **Navigation** to view commands used to move the cursor / speech focus.



A list of available commands displays.



Add Word to Vocabulary

1. If voice recognition makes a mistake on a word, correct the word with typing, then add the word to your vocabulary. This ensures voice recognition will be correct going forward.

Tip: Adding a frequently used colleague's name can be beneficial.

2. Select/highlight word.

3. Say **Add Word**.

4. **Manage Vocabulary** opens.

5. Select **Default Pronunciation** or enter word as you would pronounce it.

6. Save entry.



- To view words you have added to your vocabulary, tap on Menu (4 lines next to microphone icon), and tap Manage Vocabulary.
