Surgery Scheduling Color Meanings

Yellow	CV PeriOp/PAR 4 is the only area performing PreOp phone calls and using this grid; other areas use the tracking board. The PreOp phone call has not been completed. Patients who come to Surgical Services from an inpatient unit do not need a PreOp phone call so they will not appear in yellow. Note: A * before the Description alerts you that an attempt has already been made to contact the family for the PreOp phone call. The attempt was unsuccessful.
Light Green	The PreOp phone call has been completed by CV PeriOp/PAR4 or the appointment is confirmed.
Medium Green	The patient has arrived for surgery and has been checked in.
Dark Green	The PostOp phone call has been completed and the patient has been checked out. A patient should be checked out even if they are admitted to the hospital after their procedure to indicate a PostOp phone call is not needed.
Remain Green	Surgery appointments: Generally performed in the OR with Anesthesia and OR teams.
Orange	NORA appointments (Non-OR Anesthesia) or 1:1 Anesthesia coverage: Generally performed with an Anesthesia team and no OR team outside of the OR but may be done in an OR suite.

Schedule Colors Job Aid

Purple	Placeholder appointments: Created when a patient is moving from one area to another that involves an OR procedure. Examples include robotic cases, combo OR with a CT scan.
Pink	NORA Sedation appointments: Created when a patient has a different level of anesthesia coverage. These appointments are commonly associated with ABRs or HemOnc procedures.
