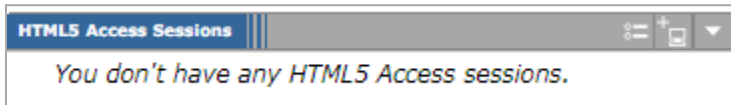


## HTML5 Remote Desktop (Terminal Session)

The HTML5 option is not platform-dependent, meaning that it can be used on any browser and with any operating system. It is not Java-dependent.

If you have access to a Remote Desktop, the **HTML5 Access Sessions** title bar will display after you log into Children's Secure Access.



After you set up a HTML5 Access session, it can be used to remote into a Children's computer desktop.

If you require Remote Desktop access to a Children's computer and do not have access, please call Children's ITS Service Desk 24/7 at 952-992-5000 (internal 4-5000).

### To set up an HTML5 access session:

- 1 Log in to Children's Secure Access (<https://www.childrensmn.org/signin>) using your Children's network username and password.
- 2 Click the  icon in the **HTML5 Access Sessions** title bar to open the Add HTML5 Access Session window.

- 3 Enter **Session Type**: Leave the default or select **HTML5 RDP Bookmark**

**Bookmark Name:** Enter any description of the remote desktop that will be accessed.

**Host:** Enter the remote **PC Name** or **IP Address**

**Server Port:** Enter **3389**

- 4 In the Authentication section, enter  
**Username:** (Your Children's network username)  
**Password:** (Your Children's network password)

- 5 All other fields can remain empty, with default values or your user preferences.
- 6 Click **Add** at the bottom of the window, under **Add HTML5 Access Session?**
