# Implementation of NAVA on SERVO-i ventilators in NICU-M

#### Why are we making this change?

NAVA is a new mode available only on our SERVO-i ventilators. NAVA stands for neurally adjusted ventilatory assist.

NAVA offers many benefits to specific patient populations including improved ventilator synchrony and decreased risk for lung injury. NAVA can be used both invasively and non-invasively.

### How can I get information on how to use NAVA?
