Q: How do I document precaution education?

Standard Precautions- documented in the orientation to Childrens section of the Admission HX. After topic is reviewed with the family, selecting "yes" satisfies the documentation requirement for standard precaution education.

Orientation to Childrens

The following "Orientation to Children's" topics should be reviewed with the patient and/or family.
